UNIFORMS

We encourage the children to take pride in their appearance and to dress in the correct uniform at all times. Here are a few practical ways you can help your children.

- ensure that uniforms are always neat, clean and tidy
- school shoes are to be polished
- no nail varnish is to be worn at school
- hairstyles to be generally tidy, with no fancy hair accessories
- sleepers or studs **ONLY** to be worn in pierced ears
- all clothing to be labelled
- the wearing of the school hat is compulsory
- a note explaining any variations in school uniform is encouraged.

School Hats

Hats are available from the school's office and are to be worn when the children go onto the playground, as stipulated by the Sun Smart Policy. The wearing of hats is a compulsory part of our school uniform. Hats should be worn to and from school. **NO HAT** means **NO PLAY** in sunny areas of the playground.

ACCESSORIES – Accessories permitted at school are limited to the following:

- A watch

- Flat signet ring
- Navy blue and/or white hair ribbons or ties.
- Joggers to be worn ONLY on Sport days
- Each year, Year 6 buys a Year 6 Special Leavers shirt. They wear this for school sport days in Term 4. It is not worn for school representative sport or when representing the school.

ALL CHILDREN ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR THE PRESCRIBED UNIFORM AND SHOULD TAKE PRIDE IN DOING SO.
