


It's that time of year again. The Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) is up and running. The Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely. During class library time, students in K-2 will listen to PRC books and I will record these for all K-2 students so they can complete the challenge. Students in 3-6 are given the opportunity to read in the library and borrow books to read at home and will need to log the books read themselves. Students will be shown how to record their books read through the PRC website in library lessons.



There is a booklist located on the PRC website with all the guidelines and rules. The number of books that students will need to read before Friday 28 August is:

Challenge	Number of books you must read	Minimum number of PRC books	Maximum number of Personal Choice books	PRC booklists you can read from
K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6, 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9



Instructions on how to record a book from home.

Go to the PRC website: https://online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc/home.html

Go to **Logon** and enter PRC username and password. I will give these to students in years 3-6.

Go to Visit the student site!

In the blue search bar, type in the title of the book read and click search. Once the desired book is shown click Add on the book.
